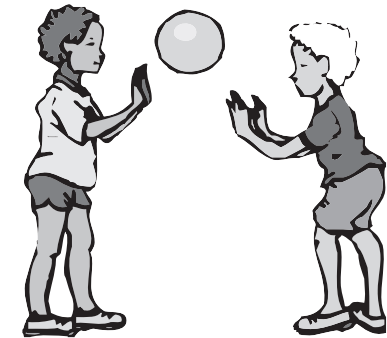

REGISTER IN PERSON OR BY MAIL

Register early: First come, First served!

Our Day Camp is in the process of becoming state certified & inspected and will meet the requirements of the Youth Safety Act prior to the start of camp. The Camp has a ten Camper per Counselor ratio and an experienced, professionally trained staff.

The attached **Health History Form** must be completed and returned with registration:

- The form must be signed a by a parent or guardian.
- This form must be accompanied by a copy of your child's **Immunization Records**, or a signed verification of immunizations from a doctor, which also must be returned with registration.
- No registration forms will be accepted and no child will be admitted into Camp without the Health History Form and the Immunization History.
NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE FOR ANY REASON.

State law mandates that no child may attend summer day camp without a completed Health History Form and up to date immunization history on file by June 17, 2011 (no matter what session your child will attend). This law is strictly enforced by the NJ State Department of Health.



FEES

Please read carefully

Registration and fees are for weekly sessions. We do not register on a daily basis. **Payment in full is required when registering for the week(s) you indicated on the registration form.** Children will not be registered for any unpaid week(s) indicated on your Child's registration form.

State certification regulations regarding the number of Campers attending our program require us to base all registrations on availability.

If you wish to add additional weeks at a later date, bring in or mail your payment with a note indicating prior registration and the additional week(s) you wish your child(ren) to attend. Remember that all registrations are based on availability. In addition, we will not accept portion payments from various sources. The parents whose signature appears on the registration form will be our contact regarding payment.

Regular Fee: Effective until Friday, June 17, 2011 – **no exceptions.** \$100 per week. Registrations received after Friday, June 17, 2011 will be charged the Late Fee. Registrations subject to availability.

Late Fee: Effective Saturday, June 18, 2011. \$110 per week. Registration subject to availability. Registration and full payment must be received by the Thursday before the week your child will attend. No registered, money or medical forms will be accepted on Friday or Monday once camp begins.

Family Discount: Families with three or more children registered may be eligible for a discount. Please call for more information.

Refund policy: Refunds are considered only in the event that your child misses three or more consecutive days due to illness. Requests for refunds must be made in writing and be accompanied by a dated and signed doctor's note, which includes the doctor's address and phone number. We will not grant refunds for changes in vacations, sport camp schedules or other personal reasons. If available, we will attempt to place your child in another session.

TYPICAL DAILY SCHEDULE

7:30am–9:00am	Children arrive at the Club.
9:00am–11:30am	All Campers are divided into age groups and follow a structured schedule of activities.
11:30am–12:30pm	Lunch (children bring their own lunch).
12:30pm–5:00pm	Children follow a structured schedule.
5:00pm–6:00pm	Parents pick up children at the Club.

Please note the pick up time will be strictly enforced.

A late fee of \$15 for every 15 minutes will be imposed on anyone who is late arriving for their child. For example 6:01-6:15 = \$15, 6:16-6:30 = \$30, etc. Late pick up fee will be due before your child can attend Camp again.

Excessive lateness will result in dismissal from Camp - no refund.
